# F12312-08 Whitestone Primary School Grant Application

**RECOMMENDED:** that the amount of £1,500 be granted to improve play yard areas.

# F12312-09 Sunshine Lotus Yoga Grant Application

Grant Application for £2,400 to support yoga within the community through Yoga 4 Health.

Prior to the meeting both The CSO and Cllr Townsend Jones had updated committee members on contact with the applicant and a Swansea City Council Co-ordinator. Following a discussion on the merits of supporting this application it was decided by a majority of three to two not to support the application. A further application in the future would be appropriate.

**RESOLVED** not to support the application

#### F12312-10 Mumbles Rugby Club Grant Application

Grant Application for £2,000 to contribute towards the community-based annual festival.

Prior to the meeting, The CSO had updated the committee on his contact with applicant, addressing points of concern from October's Meeting.



A discussion took place on the merits of providing a grant to support the rugby festival. Although concerns remained that the application was made retrospectively the committee was impressed by the efforts of Mumbles Rugby Club to be more inclusive.

**RECOMMENDED:** that the amount of £2,000 be granted to contribute towards the community-based annual rugby festival.
