4. **DECLARATION OF INTEREST:-** None
5. **ROAD SAFETY.**
 - a) **Mayals Green:-** To make Mayals Green a 'no through road'.
Email sent to Jeff Green, CCS, 16 August 2013, as suggested last meeting, making enquiries as to whether, if MCC was to fully fund the scheme, would there be any problems with TRO being approved, also, when will CCS be arranging a traffic survey.
Awaiting a reply.
 - b) **St. Peter's Church, Newton:-** Double yellow lines.
Reply received from Mark Thomas, CCS, 19 August 2013, stating the matter will be raised with the 'ward member' for his consideration. (Bearing in mind, this work has been paid for). Councillor Miles Thomas, as CCS, totally opposed to the double yellow lines being sited alongside the church.
 - c) **West Cross Lane / Bellevue Road:-** Double yellow lines.

 - e) **Southerdown Avenue / Mayals Road:-** Make 'one way' from Mayals Road.

 - f) **Mulberry Avenue:-** White centre carriageway lines.
Email sent to Mark Thomas, CCS, 16 August 2013, re-iterating the problems and reasons for the request for 'white lines' between Cypress Avenue and Chestnut Avenue.
