Road Safety

A meeting was held on Friday, 16 May 2014 between:-
C&CS Highways :- Mark Thomas and Jeff green
MCC Councillors :- B.Arthur, P.Birch and H.Mitchell.
(This meeting was approved by full council 8 April 2014)
The following agreements were reached.

HW14.083 Mayals Green :-To make a 'No through Road'

RECOMMEND MCC begin negotiations with C&CS regarding scheduling the work.

HW14.084 St. Peter's Church, Newton :-Reach an agreement on parking

Agreed to re-visit the site. Residence living opposite the Church to

contact C&CS. (This work has already been paid for).

HW14.085 West Cross Lane / Bellevue Road :- Double yellow lines

Plans now to be drawn up and submitted to MCC. TRO not required.

HW14.086 Mulberry Avenue, West Cross :- White centre carriageway lines

Speed survey results been received :- Maximum speed recorded at 33mph. Explained that speed was not the issue, but the position of traffic on the bend. C&CS Highways agreed and suggested work could be carried out under 'maintenance', therefore TRO not required.

HW14.087 Plunch Lane :- Double yellow lines

Work to be advertised and scheduled.

HW14.088 Castle Road :- Double yellow lines

In hand. Work to be advertised and scheduled.

Parking Problems

HW14.089 Newton Road

Discussed at meeting, 16 May 2014. Plans to be prepared for MCC approval and delivery times on Newton Road to be addressed and enforced.

HW14.090 Top Shops, West Cross Lane

Discussed at meeting, 16 May 2014. Estimated cost could be up to £2K, depending on number of bollards needed. TRO not required.

HW14.091 Heathwood Road

Discussed at meeting, 16 May 2014. TRO not required to provide a 'No through road' sign. Estimated cost is £1k.
Clerk to contact West Cross Housing.

HW14.092 Rotherslade Road

Discussed at meeting, 16 May 2014. C&CS explained that erecting a 'No through road' sign was not feasible or cost effective. It was suggested a new / separate sign be mounted on the existing posts, below the road signage.
To follow up with C&CS.

HW14.096 Footpath at Llwynderw

Brought back onto agenda. Cllr. L.Tyler-Lloyd (as CCS) been in discussions with C&CS. More enquiries to be made as to whether there are any underground services on site, before discussions as to funding.

HW14.097 Alderwood Road

Emails received from Cllr. B.Arthur and P.C.Richard Jeavons, SW Police regarding deliveries in Alderwood Road. Police appear to have sorted the problem, so no action required by MCC.

Item discharged.

HW14.098 Request to ban BBQ's on Beaches

No up-date at present. Clerk to pursue the possibility of a 'ban' with Bishopston Community Council. It was suggested a meeting be held with C&CS with the view of pursuing the possibility of 'litter patrols' and provision of bins and signs on the beaches. The steps leading to Rotherslade beach are being damaged also.
